



GANPI MATERIAL WOOD

[GANPI ABAKA]

Ganpi, a unique Japanese art paper material, is made of precious natural fibres which are gathered from 8 year old trees found in the higher altitude of mountains, and is very tough and has beautiful luster in characteristic.

Abaka is made of the fibre derived from the stem of Manila hemp in perennial and Manila hemp is grown in Philippine and Indonesia.

The new paper yarn "Ganpi Abaka" blended 2 kinds of natural fibres Ganpi and Abaka could be characterised both a beautiful luster in Ganpi and a light and flexible in Abaka, and also mild on skin and the environment.
